Dear Parents and Guardians,

Clairvaux Primary School continues to welcome the collaboration of allied health workers appointed by families as we deeply value their contributions to enhancing our teaching methods for your children and the overall wellbeing of our students.

The inclusion of these professionals, such as speech therapists, psychologists and occupational therapists, allows us to provide a more comprehensive and supportive educational environment. To ensure the smooth integration of these services, we kindly request that you complete the necessary forms available on our website under Wellbeing, Therapist Information. The forms that need to be completed and returned to school are: Therapist Forms, Parent Consent Form and the Information Sharing Form. These forms are crucial for facilitating the involvement of allied health workers within our school community and ensuring child safety for our wider community.

Therapists need to be registered with Sam 4 Schools. If they are not registered they will need to contact the school office and they will organise this for them.

Allied health support staff are not permitted to be in classrooms due to privacy concerns for the other students in the class. It is still possible to book in for 1:1 sessions and/or yard observations to support students at Clairvaux. Please contact the child's class teacher to make sure that proposed sessions do not impact important school learning or events. (If unsure of the child's class teacher's email, please contact myself or the school office)

It is important to note that any allied health workers employed at Clairvaux Primary School are here on an educational basis. Their primary role is to support our teachers by addressing teacher referrals for students who may benefit from their expertise and to support in class group support when required. They are not employed to conduct clinical assessments for families or to undertake one-on-one sessions with students.
